


This guide is an overview of branded materials to help your school or organization promote NC College Connect. This includes an itemized list of materials as well as recommendations for use.

### How to Use: One-Pager

- The following NC College Connect one-pager has been developed to provide another way to amplify NC College Connect with students at your school or college and in your communities.
- This one-pager is sized to print on 8.5x11" paper. Print this to share at events and with those in your network. It is not designed for sharing on social media and should not be used in that medium.
- This one-pager is also included in the downloadable file on the NC College Connect resources page for education professionals.

NC College Connect is a program that offers qualified students the opportunity for a simplified application process at select UNC System universities and their local North Carolina community college—as long as they meet state graduation requirements and UNC System course requirements.

#### Here's what you need to know.

- 1. If you have a weighted GPA of 2.8 or above, you have the opportunity for a simplified application process to the participating NC colleges and universities.
- 2. To claim your spot, you should scan the QR code on your letter (or the one below!) to visit NCCollegeConnect.org.
- 3. There you will find a "Claim Your Spot" button that will take you to the NC College Connect portal if you are already logged into your CFNC account. (Tip: If you are not logged in, you will be asked to log in using your CFNC credentials or create a new CFNC account.)
- 4. After logging in, you will see a list of colleges and universities where you can complete a simplified application for each institution.
- 5. Once you've submitted your simplified application(s), the college(s) will contact you with more information about next steps.
- 6. These simplified applications will have fees, possibly ranging from \$30 to \$75. Submit your simplified application during College Application Week (October 21-27, 2024) to avoid application fees for most participating institutions.


# → Social Media Graphics



#### **General Version**

These select North Carolina colleges and universities are holding spots for eligible students. That's right! A simple, streamlined process that gets students where they want to be.


